Instructions for Student Ambassador Application

Thank you for your interest in becoming a HCF Campus Ambassador.

HCF Campus Ambassadors are current students from various historically black colleges or university and predominately black institutions selected on the basis of leadership, scholarship, and desire to promote their HBCU/PBI and HBCU Campaign Fund (HCF) both on and off campus. Minimum qualifications include:

1. Must currently be enrolled at an accredited community or 4-year historically black college or university or predominately black institution.
2. Must be a full-time student.
3. Must have a cumulative GPA of at least a 2.5.
4. Must be able to commit to serving one academic year. (Fall-Spring)
5. Demonstrate strong communication (verbal and written) and interpersonal skills.
6. Exhibit leadership, initiative, dependability, discipline, and enthusiasm.

Student Ambassador Responsibilities

Campus Ambassadors will engage HBCU pride, their college or university and HCF on and off campus at any event that they will attend. Ambassadors will participate in mentoring, recruitment, and leadership activities.

- Serve as a liaison between the college or university and HCF.
 - Communicate the mission, vision, and culture of your college or university and the HBCU experience.
 - Recruit for your college or university and work on different initiatives and issues about HBCU's.
 - Represent HCF during attended events.
 - Assist HCF with planning events and task related to events planned by the Div. of Social Affairs.
 - Provide tips on being a successful college student.
 - Attend all planned meetings and any required workshops.
 - Other duties as assigned.

- Ambassadors will also assist with on-campus marketing.
 - Ambassadors will be expected to spend at least one hour per week on Ambassador activities.
 - Ambassadors should expect to spend no more than 3-5 hours a week on Ambassador activities.
 - Ambassadors should expect to spend around no more than 20 hours per semester on Ambassador activities.

Application Procedures

1. Submit application to HCF **NO LATER THAN** August 15, 2018.
2. One letter of recommendation from one of the following: College or University President, Staff or Instructor/Professor.
3. Unofficial Transcript.
4. Current resume.
5. All selected Ambassadors will be notified by August 24, 2018.
6. Campus Ambassadors packets will be email **NO LATER THAN** August 30, 2018.
